TAG FISH PROMOTION

FEB 16TH THROUGH MARCH 4TH AT 5PM

RULES

1. The fish must be caught from the waters of Santa Ana River Lakes, or Corona Lake, during open business hours of 6am to 4pm (Day fishing) or 5pm to 11pm (night fishing) during the Tag Fish Promotion period beginning February 16th, 2012 and ending March 4th, 2012 at 5pm.
2. The fish must be caught using a fishing rod, reel, line and no more than two conventional hooks on the fishing line, with bait, artificial lures or flies. No minnows, live fish or crawdads may be used, limit two rods per fisherman.
3. The fish must be caught in the mouth, not snagged on any other portion of the fish body. A regular fish net may be used to "boat the fish" or "land the fish" while the hook is still secured to the inside of the fish mouth.
4. No set lines, multi hooked rigs, snagging devices, gill nets, throw nets, snagging or other trapping devices may be used to catch fish.
5. The fish must be freshly caught, not stiff or dried out and the TAG MUST BE SECURELY fixed to the dorsal fin of the fish (THE TAG MUST NOT BE REMOVED). The fish must be presented to Lake Management immediately after catch for examination and certification for payoff.
6. Violation of any of the above rules will void the payoff to that person violating the rules or regulations. In the event of any dispute, Lake Management decision will be final.
7. Employees, owners or stockholders of Corona Recreation, Inc., employees of Insurance Company or their family members are not eligible to participate in the Tag Fish Promotion or receive any tag cash pay off.
8. In the event a fisherman observes a violation of these tag fish rules, the fisherman must register the complaint of violation immediately on observation, so that Management can make a timely and correct evaluation of the complaint of violation. Complaints made after the award of tag payoff, will not be considered as relevant.
