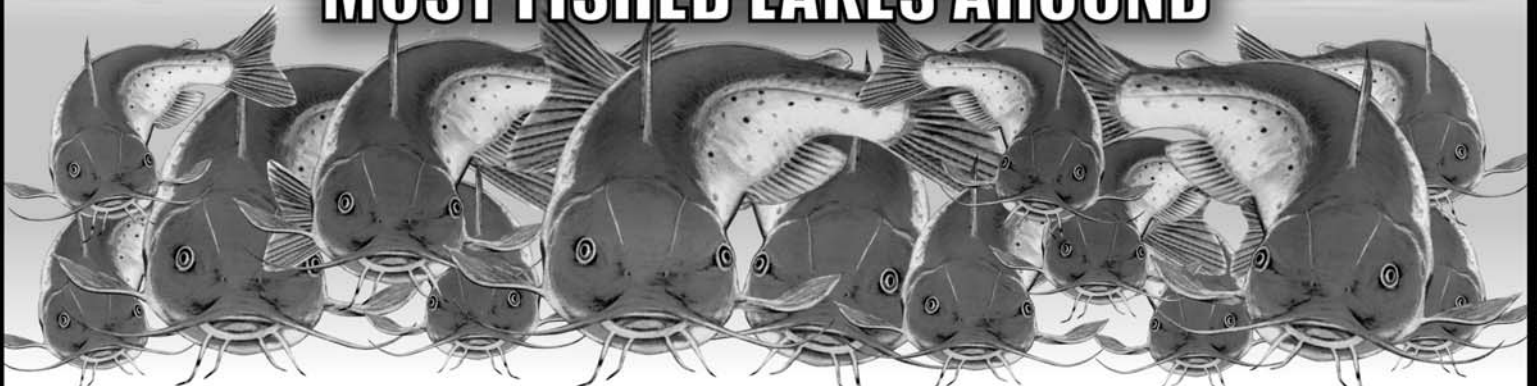

ADMISSION FEES, HOURS & LIMITS: Effective 5/21/12

(Day Session, 6am to 4pm - Night Session, 5pm to 11pm)
Adults (13 to 61, - 5 Fish Limit)\$25
Young Kids (3 and under Free, 4 to 12, - 3 Fish Limit)\$12
Seniors (62 and over, ID required, - 5 Fish Limit)\$23
Senior's Day - Every Wednesday, - 5 Fish Limit)\$20

MID-DAY ADMISSION FEES: (12:30pm to 11pm)

Adults (13 and up, - 7 Fish Limit)\$35
Kids (Under 3 Free, 4 to 12, - 5 Fish Limit)\$20

24-HOUR FISHING AND FREE CAMPING:

(Friday and Saturday Evenings, 5pm to 4pm - Seasonal)
Adults (15 Fish Limit)\$75

24-HOUR FAMILY SPECIAL: (NEW AGES FOR SPECIAL)
Dad pays the regular 24-hour admission fee and mom and up
to 3 minors, under 18, get in FREE and can help dad catch his
15 fish limit. PLUS, no extra fee for camping... WHAT A DEAL!!

BOAT RENTALS AND LAUNCH FEES:

Boat and Motor (Day or Night Session)\$50
1/2 Day Boat & Motor (11:30 to 4, Day Session Only).....\$25
24-Hour Fishing (5pm to 4pm)\$100

Row Boat (Day or Night Session)\$20
1/2 Day Row Boat (11:30 to 4pm, Day Session Only)\$10
24-Hour Fishing (5pm to 4pm)\$40

Pontoon Boat (Day or Night Session - Up to 8 people).....\$100
1/2 Day Pontoon (11:30 to 4pm, Day Session Only)\$50
24-Hour Fishing (5pm to 4pm)\$200

Private Boat Launch Fee (Clean, Dry & Inspected)\$10
Float Tube, Kick Boat or Kayak Launch Fee\$4
Only Clean Dry & Inspected Tubes & Watercraft will be allowed.

COMBINED LIMIT = ANY 5 FISH OF THE FOLLOWING:

Trout - Catfish - Tilapia - Sturgeon - Bass

Large Catfish and Sturgeon caught above 25 pounds are Catch and Release ONLY. A FREE Gate Pass or Boat/Motor Rental will be awarded for a safe release and photo of the Catfish or Sturgeon. Also, Bass (Largemouth or Wiper) Catch and release is required above 5 pounds.

FISH LIMITS:

YOU MUST QUIT FISHING WHEN YOU CATCH YOUR LIMIT

Day or Night Session

Adults - 5 Fish Combined Limit

Kids - 3 Fish Combined Limit

Example: 2 Trout + 2 Catfish + 1 Tilapia = 1 Full Adult Limit

SPECIAL LIMITS:

Mid-Day Special = 1 Combined Limit + 2 Extra Fish

24-Hour Special = 3 Combined Limits or 15 Fish

Crappie Only Limit = 10 Fish* - Any size up to 3 pounds. Crappie over 3 pounds - Catch and Release is required.

* If caught along with a 5 Fish Combined Limit described above, the limit is 5 Crappie. 24-Hour Fishing = 3 Limits.

Example: 2 Catfish + 3 Tilapia + 5 Crappie = 1 Full Limit

Bluegill Only Limit = 10 Fish* - Any size up to 2 pounds. Bluegill over 2 pounds - Catch and Release is required.

* If caught along with a 5 Fish Combined Limit described above, the limit is 5 Bluegill. 24-Hour Fishing = 3 Limits.

Example: 2 Catfish + 3 Tilapia + 5 Bluegill = 1 Full Limit

Carp Only Limit = 10 Fish* - All Sizes.

* If caught along with a 5 Fish Combined Limit described above, the limit is 5 Carp. 24-Hour Fishing = 3 Limits.

Example: 2 Catfish + 3 Tilapia + 5 Carp = 1 Full Limit

ALL RULES ARE STRONGLY ENFORCED

(Please report violations to Management in Tackle Shop)

VIOLATING ANY LAKE RULE CAN RESULT IN EXPULSION MANAGEMENT CAN REFUSE SERVICE FOR ANY REASON

OVER LIMIT FINE = \$8 PER POUND AND THE LARGEST FISH WILL BE WEIGHED TO DETERMINE THE FINE. YOU WILL ALSO BE EXPELLED FROM THE LAKE. ICE CHESTS AND VEHICLES ARE SUBJECT TO INSPECTION. CATCHING MORE THAN YOUR LIMIT IS CONSIDERED THEFT IF YOU CAN'T PAY THE FINE, AND YOU CAN BE ARRESTED!!

A SECOND LIMIT PASS CAN BE PURCHASED AFTER YOU HAVE CAUGHT YOUR LIMIT, BUT YOU MUST FIRST EXIT AND RE-ENTER THE MAIN ENTRANCE. YOU CANNOT PURCHASE A SECOND LIMIT PASS IF YOU ARE OVER YOUR LIMIT, BECAUSE THE ABOVE RULE AND FINE WILL APPLY.

No refunds, rain checks, wind checks or free spectators.
No exiting and re-entering Lakes w/o paying entrance fee.
No pets of any kind are permitted on the premises.
No crawdads, live fish bait or is chumming allowed.
No catch and release - unless required above.
No culling for a larger limit of fish. Keep what you catch.
No fishing to help fill another angler's limit.
No netting or snagging fish, they must be mouth hooked.
No fishing next to the stocking areas for at least 2 hours.
No more than 2 rods in the water for each fisherman.
No more than 8 foot of shore space per each angler.
No loud music, loud kids, or excessive alcohol use.
No discarding old line/trash in the water or along the shore.
No harassing or disturbing any of the wildlife at the Lakes.
No rock throwing, slingshots, pellet or BB-Guns.
No fishing from a boat closer than 100 feet from shore.
No operating a boat over 5 MPH or creating a wake.
